FOR the purpose of requiring the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City or the

tax imposed on real property equipped with programmable thermostats;
providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to a local
property tax credit for property equipped with programmable thermostats.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE CITY OR THE 19 GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY OR OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION SHALL 20 GRANT, BY LAW, A TAX CREDIT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100 AGAINST THE COUNTY 21 OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION PROPERTY TAX IMPOSED ON REAL PROPERTY 22 EQUIPPED WITH PROGRAMMABLE THERMOSTATS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 June 1, 2008, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after June 30,
 2008.
