## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems – Executive**  
3 **Director – Appointment**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to appoint the Executive Director of the  
5 Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems; providing that the  
6 Executive Director serves at the pleasure of the Governor; making stylistic  
7 changes; and generally relating to the Executive Director of the Maryland  
8 Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
10 Article – Education  
11 Section 13–506  
12 Annotated Code of Maryland  
13 (2006 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Education**

17 13–506.

18 (a) [With the approval of the Governor, the EMS Board] **THE GOVERNOR**  
19 shall appoint an Executive Director.

20 (b) The Executive Director serves at the pleasure of the [EMS Board]  
21 **GOVERNOR.**

22 (c) The Executive Director is entitled to the salary provided in the State  
23 budget.

1            ~~[(c)]~~ **(D)**      Under the direction of the EMS Board, the Executive Director  
2 shall:

3                    (1)      Be the administrative head of the EMS Board;

4                    (2)      Be the administrative head of the Institute; and

5                    (3)      Perform any other duty or function that the EMS Board requires.

6            ~~[(d)]~~ **(E)**      Any foundation created by the EMS Board shall be subject to audit  
7 by the Office of Legislative Audits.

8            SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
9 October 1, 2008.
