## A BILL ENTITLED

## AN ACT concerning

## State Lottery - Lottery for Benefit of Thoroughbred and Standardbred Breeders

FOR the purpose of requiring the State Lottery Agency to conduct in each fiscal year a certain number of horse racing lottery games for the benefit of the Maryland Thoroughbred Breeders Fund and the Maryland Standardbred Breeders Fund; requiring that certain advertising and tickets be identified in a certain way; requiring that the proceeds from the games be distributed in a certain way; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to State lottery games for the benefit of the Maryland Thoroughbred Breeders Fund and the Maryland Standardbred Breeders Fund.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - State Government

9-120.
(a) The Comptroller shall distribute the State Lottery Fund to pay:
(1) on a pro rata basis for the daily and nondaily State lottery games, the expenses of administering and operating the State lottery, as authorized under this subtitle and the State budget; and
(2) then, except as provided in § 10-113.1 of the Family Law Article and § 11-618 of the Criminal Procedure Article, the holder of each winning ticket or share.
(b) (1) Promptly after the 1st day of each month, AFTER THE DISTRIBUTION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, the Comptroller shall pay:
(i) into the Maryland Stadium Facilities Fund the money that remains in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of the sports lotteries conducted for the benefit of the Maryland Stadium Authority[, after the distribution under subsection (a) of this section; and];
(II) INTO THE MARYLAND THOROUGHBRED BREEDERS FUND AND THE MARYLAND STANDARDBRED BREEDERS FUND THE PROCEEDS FROM HORSE RACING LOTTERIES, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 9-120.2 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
[(ii)] (III) into the General Fund of the State the money that remains in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of all other lotteries [after the distribution under subsection (a) of this section].
(2) The money paid into the General Fund under this subsection is available in the fiscal year in which the money accumulates in the State Lottery Fund.
(c) The regulations of the Agency shall apportion the money in the State Lottery Fund.

(A) DURING EACH FISCAL YEAR THE AGENCY SHALL CONDUCT AT LEAST ONE HORSE RACING LOTTERY FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE MARYLAND Thoroughbred Breeders Fund and the Maryland Standardbred BREEDERS FUND.
(B) IN ALL ADVERTISING AND ON TICKETS, THE AGENCY SHALL IDENTIFY ANY LOTTERY GAME UNDER THIS SECTION AS BEING CONDUCTED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE MARYLAND THOROUGHBRED BREEDERS FUND AND THE MARYLAND STANDARDBRED BREEDERS FUND.

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(C) PROCEEDS FROM THE HORSE RACING LOTTERIES SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED AS FOLLOWS:

(2) $\mathbf{2 0} \%$ TO THE MARYLAND STANDARDBRED BREEDERS FUND.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008. It shall remain effective for a period 3 years and, at the end of September 30, 2011, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
