13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings

17 (a) (1) A person who leaves an unharmed newborn with a responsible 18 adult within [3] **10** days after the birth of the newborn, as determined within a 19 reasonable degree of medical certainty, and does not express an intent to return for 20 the newborn shall be immune from civil liability or criminal prosecution for the act.

21 (2) If the person leaving a newborn under this subsection is not the 22 mother of the newborn, the person shall have the approval of the mother to do so.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 24 October 1, 2008.
