# A BILL ENTITLED

## 1 AN ACT concerning

#### 2 Condominiums – Annual Proposed Budget – Required Form and Information

- FOR the purpose of requiring an annual proposed budget submitted to a council of unit owners of a condominium to include certain information reasonably necessary for the informed adoption of the annual budget; requiring certain information to be provided for each item included in the budget; and generally relating to the form and contents of an annual proposed budget of a condominium.

## 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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## Article – Real Property

17 11–109.2.

(a) The council of unit owners shall cause to be prepared and submitted tothe unit owners an annual proposed budget at least 30 days before its adoption.

- 21 (1) Income;
- 22 (2) Administration;

17 18 19 20 21 22 23	[(d)] (E) Any expenditure made other than those made because of conditions which, if not corrected, could reasonably result in a threat to the health or safety of the unit owners or a significant risk of damage to the condominium, that would result in an increase in an amount of assessments for the current fiscal year of the condominium in excess of 15 percent of the budgeted amount previously adopted, shall be approved by an amendment to the budget adopted at a special meeting, upon not less than 10 days written notice to the council of unit owners.
