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## Birth Options Preservation Act Study

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the State Board of Nursing from requiring nurse 4 midwives to have certain written agreements with physicians; requiring nurse midwives to make available to the Board a copy of certain Practice Guidelines 5 6 under certain circumstances; defining a certain term requiring the State Board 7 of Nursing and the State Board of Physicians to conduct a joint study on a 8 requirement for a certain agreement between a certified nurse-midwife and a 9 licensed physician; requiring that the Boards collaborate with certain entities; requiring that the study include a review of certain standards and determine 10 certain recommendations; requiring the Boards to report to certain committees 11 of the General Assembly on or before a certain date; and generally relating to 12 13 the practice a study of nurse midwifery.
