Vehicle Laws - Gold Star Registration Plates

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a recipient of the U.S. Department of Defense Gold 4 Star as the surviving spouse, parent, or next of kin of a member of the armed 5 forces whose life was lost in combat to apply under certain circumstances to the Motor Vehicle Administration for assignment of a special registration plate; 6 7 requiring the surviving spouse, parent, or next of kin applying for a special Gold Star registration plate to provide certain proof to the Administration; requiring 8 9 the special Gold Star registration plate to display certain information; clarifying 10 language; and generally relating to eligibility for special vehicle registration 11 plates.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(a) (1) The owner of a motor vehicle, or a lessee of the vehicle under a
lease not intended as security, or a director, officer, employee, or partner of a business
entity that owns the vehicle may apply to the Administration for the assignment of a
special registration number and special registration plates under this section for a
vehicle included in one of the following classes:

1 A Class A (passenger) vehicle; (i) $\mathbf{2}$ (ii) A Class E (truck) vehicle with a one ton or less 3 manufacturer's rated capacity; 4 A Class M (multipurpose) vehicle; or (iii) 5 (iv) A Class D (motorcycle) vehicle. 6 To be eligible for a special registration **DESCRIBED** under (2)

6 (2) To be eligible for a special registration **DESCRIBED** under 7 subsection (c)(2)(i) of this section, an applicant shall provide proof that is satisfactory 8 to the Administration that the applicant is a recipient of an individually earned, 9 combat-related, armed forces medal.

10 (3) To be eligible for a special registration **DESCRIBED** under 11 subsection (c)(2)(ii) of this section, an applicant shall provide proof that is satisfactory 12 to the Administration that the applicant is an honorably discharged veteran of a 13 branch of the armed forces of the United States.

14 (4) TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION DESCRIBED 15 UNDER SUBSECTION (C)(2)(III) OF THIS SECTION, AN APPLICANT SHALL 16 PROVIDE PROOF THAT IS SATISFACTORY TO THE ADMINISTRATION THAT THE 17 APPLICANT IS A RECIPIENT OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE GOLD 18 STAR FOR SURVIVING SPOUSES, PARENTS, AND NEXT OF KIN OF MEMBERS OF 19 THE ARMED FORCES WHO LOST THEIR LIVES IN COMBAT.

20 (b) (1) In addition to the annual registration fee otherwise required under 21 this title, an owner of a vehicle assigned a special registration under this section shall 22 pay a fee as determined by the Administration each time new registration plates are 23 issued for the vehicle. The fee shall be calculated to recover the costs incurred by the 24 Administration in carrying out the provisions of this section.

(2) The additional fee charged under this section shall be retained by
the Administration for the purpose of recovering the Administration's costs under this
section, and may not be credited to the Gasoline and Motor Vehicle Revenue Account
for distribution under § 8–403 or § 8–404 of this article.

- 11. An emblem or logo as authorized by the2Administration that depicts the APPLICANT'S ARMED FORCES medal; and
- 3 2. Except on plates issued for Class D (motorcycle)
 4 vehicles, words describing the medal printed across the bottom of the plates; [or]

5 (ii) Words or an emblem or logo indicating that the special 6 registration plate holder is an honorably discharged veteran of a branch of the armed 7 forces of the United States; **OR**

8 (III) AN EMBLEM OR LOGO INDICATING THAT THE 9 REGISTRATION PLATE HOLDER IS THE RECIPIENT OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT 10 OF DEFENSE GOLD STAR.

11 (d) (1) The Administration, in consultation with the U.S. Department of 12 Defense and appropriate representatives of the various branches of the armed forces, 13 shall adopt regulations specifying those armed forces medals that are of the type 14 described in subsection (a)(2) of this section and which, when awarded to an 15 individual, qualify that individual to apply for special registration under this section.

16 (2) The Administration may adopt other regulations as necessary to 17 govern the issuance of special registration numbers and special registration plates 18 under this section.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 July 1, 2008.
