13	<b>Article – State Personnel and Pensions</b>

15 16 17	(a) For purposes of a layoff, an appointing authority shall compute [the following] <b>THE TOTAL NUMBER OF SENIORITY</b> points for each employee subject to the layoff <b>AS FOLLOWS</b> :
18	(1) one point for each month of State employment;
19 20	(2) one point for each month of employment in the principal unit in which the layoff will occur; [and]

(4) TEN POINTS FOR AN ELIGIBLE VETERAN; AND

2 (5) TWO POINTS FOR AN ELIGIBLE VETERAN WHO HAS A 3 SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY OR IS A FORMER PRISONER OF WAR.

4 (b) An employee's seniority points are the total of the points determined 5 under subsection (a) of this section.

6 (C) IN THIS SECTION, "ELIGIBLE VETERAN" HAS THE MEANING STATED 7 IN § 7–207(C) OF THIS ARTICLE.

8 (D) AN ELIGIBLE VETERAN WHO IS CONVICTED OF A CRIME AFTER 9 BEING DISCHARGED FROM OR COMPLETING MILITARY SERVICE IS INELIGIBLE 10 FOR A CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
October 1, 2008.
