1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Juvenile Causes – Confidentiality of Records – Access by Division of Parole**
3 **and Probation and Parole Commission**

4 FOR the purpose of altering access to juvenile records by the Division of Parole and
5 Probation and the Parole Commission; and generally relating to juvenile
6 records.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

15 3–8A–27.

16 (d) This section does not prohibit access to or use of any juvenile record by
17 the Maryland Division of Parole and Probation or the Maryland Parole Commission
18 when the Division or the Commission is carrying out any of their statutory duties
19 [either at the direction of a court of competent jurisdiction, or when the Maryland
20 Parole Commission is carrying out any of its statutory duties, if the record concerns a
21 charge or adjudication of delinquency].

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 2008.
