## A BILL ENTITLED

2	State Highway Administration - Snow Removal - Use of Far	m Trucks

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Highway Administration to request the use of certain farm trucks to assist in snow removal; authorizing the owner of a farm truck to refuse to allow the Administration to use the farm truck; requiring the Administration to compensate the owner of a farm truck that is used by the Administration for snow removal; authorizing the Administration to adopt certain regulations; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the use of farm trucks by the State Highway Administration for snow removal.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## **Article - Transportation**

23 8–602.

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24 (a) The Administration shall:



$1\\2$	(1) Keep all State highways reasonably clear of brush, snow, and other debris; and
3 4 5	(2) Remove from a State highway, as soon as its presence is made known to the Administration, any animal carcass that will impede traffic or substantially endanger the safety of the traveling public.
6 7	(b) (1) In removing snow from highways in Garrett County, the Administration:
8 9	(i) Shall avoid blocking completely the entrance to any home or business adjacent to the highway; and
10 11	(ii) May not throw or pile snow against any building in any way that interferes with the use of the building by its owner or occupant.
12 13 14	(2) If, in unusual circumstances, the entrance to any home or business is blocked in the course of snow removal, the Administration shall unblock the entrance within a reasonable time.
15 16	(C) (1) In this subsection, "farm truck" has the meaning stated in $\S$ 13–921 of this article.
17 18 19	(2) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY REQUEST THAT THE OWNER OF A FARM TRUCK ALLOW THE ADMINISTRATION TO USE THE FARM TRUCK TO ASSIST IN SNOW REMOVAL.
20 21 22	(3) THE OWNER OF A FARM TRUCK MAY REFUSE A REQUEST MADE UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION TO ALLOW THE ADMINISTRATION TO USE THE FARM TRUCK.
23 24	(4) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL COMPENSATE THE OWNER OF A FARM TRUCK THAT IS USED BY THE ADMINISTRATION FOR SNOW REMOVAL.
25 26	(5) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION.

28	(a) In this section, "farm truck" means a farm vehicle that:

30  $\,$  (2) Has a shipping weight of its chassis and battery, as certified by the 31 manufacturer, of more than 3/4 ton.

Is a Class E (truck) vehicle; and

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$\frac{1}{2}$	(b) On application, the Administration shall issue a Class E "farm truck registration" to any applicant who certifies:
3	(1) That the applicant is a farmer; and
4 5	(2) That the vehicle for which the application is made is a farm truck, specifying its proposed use.
6 7	(c) For each vehicle registered under this section, the annual registration fee is based on the maximum gross vehicle weight, as follows:
8 9 10 11	$\begin{array}{ll} \text{Maximum Gross Weight} & \text{Fee (per 1,000 Pounds} \\ \text{Limit (in Pounds)} & \text{or Fraction Thereof)} \\ 10,000 \text{ (minimum)} - 40,000 & \$5.00 \\ 40,001 - 65,000 \text{ (maximum)} & \$5.25 \end{array}$
12 13	(d) [A] <b>EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 8–602(C) OF THIS ARTICLE, A</b> vehicle registered under this section may not be used:
14 15	(1) [for] FOR hire except to haul farm products for another [farmer.] FARMER; OR
16	[(e) A vehicle registered under this section may not be used]
17	(2) [in] IN any manner other than as a farm truck.
18 19	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
