1 AN ACT concerning

Calvert County - Authorization to Harvest Seafood and Engage in the Seafood Industry

FOR the purpose of authorizing the governing body of Calvert County to adopt an 4 ordinance, resolution, or regulation or take other action to authorize a person to 5 engage in certain activities related to the seafood industry and to harvest 6 seafood; clarifying that the governing body of Calvert County is required to hold 7 8 a public hearing and obtain the written consent of the Secretary of Natural 9 Resources before adopting a certain ordinance, resolution, or regulation; providing that an ordinance, resolution, or regulation adopted by the governing 10 body of Calvert County under this Act without written consent of the Secretary 11 is void; providing that in the event of a certain conflict, federal law, State law, 12 or a certain written program guidance preempts a certain ordinance, resolution, 13 or regulation adopted by the governing body of Calvert County under this Act; 14 and generally relating to the authority of the governing body of Calvert County 15to authorize a person to engage in certain activities related to the seafood 16 industry and to harvest seafood. 17
