1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2006 - Montgomery County -**
3 **Circle Manor**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2006
5 to alter the authorized uses of a certain grant and to extend the date by which
6 the County Executive and County Council of Montgomery County must present
7 evidence that a matching fund will be provided.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **DESIGN, RENOVATION, AND DEMOLITION** of [Circle]
23 **WARNER** Manor, located in Kensington, subject to a
24 requirement that the grantee grant and convey a historic

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Section 1(5) of this Act, the matching fund may consist of

PRESENT EVIDENCE THAT A MATCHING FUND WILL BE
PROVIDED (Montgomery County)
