# Health Occupations Boards - Investigators - Confidentiality of Medical Information and Records

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to
provide a certain office space to each investigator for a health occupations
board; requiring an investigator for a health occupations board to maintain the
confidentiality of certain medical information and medical records in accordance
with the purposes and requirements of certain State and federal law; and
generally relating to the confidentiality of medical information and records by
health occupations boards investigators.

## **Article – Health Occupations**

19 **1–214.** 

20(A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE AN INDIVIDUAL AND21SECURABLE OFFICE SPACE TO EACH INVESTIGATOR FOR A HEALTH22OCCUPATIONS BOARD.

23(B)EACH INVESTIGATOR FOR A HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARD SHALL24MAINTAIN THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF ALL HEALTH CARE INFORMATION AND



1 MEDICAL RECORDS OBTAINED BY THE INVESTIGATOR IN THE COURSE OF AN 2 INVESTIGATION FOR A HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH 3 THE PURPOSES AND REQUIREMENTS OF TITLE 4, SUBTITLE 3 OF THE 4 HEALTH – GENERAL ARTICLE AND THE FEDERAL HEALTH INSURANCE 5 PORTABILITY AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2008.
