15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

19 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this Division II does
20 not apply to:

6 Department of Health and Mental Hygiene in regulation; **AND**

7 **(XVIII) THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES FOR**
8 **THE REHABILITATION OF ARCHITECTURALLY OR HISTORICALLY SIGNIFICANT**
9 **STRUCTURES AS DETERMINED BY THE MARYLAND HISTORICAL TRUST;**

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 July 1, 2008.
