FOR the purpose of exempting the renovation of historic properties by the Department of General Services from certain provisions of the State procurement law.
BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – State Finance and Procurement Section 11–203(a)(1)(xvi) and (xvii) Annotated Code of Maryland (2006 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement)
BY adding to Article – State Finance and Procurement Section 11–203(a)(1)(xviii) Annotated Code of Maryland (2006 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement)
SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
Article - State Finance and Procurement
11–203.
(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this Division II does not apply to:
(1) procurement by:



1	(xvi) the Maryland Energy Administration, when negotiating or
2	entering into grants or cooperative agreements with private entities to meet federal
3	specifications or solicitation requirements related to energy conservation, energy
4	efficiency, or renewable energy projects that benefit the State; [and]
5	(xvii) the Maryland Developmental Disabilities Administration of
6	the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene for family and individual support
7	services, and individual family care services, as those terms are defined by the
8	Department of Health and Mental Hygiene in regulation; AND
9	(XVIII) THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES FOR
10	THE REHABILITATION OF ARCHITECTURALLY OR HISTORICALLY SIGNIFICANT
11	STRUCTURES AS DETERMINED BY THE MARYLAND HISTORICAL TRUST;
12	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13	July 1, 2008.
