18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 RENOVATION OF A STRUCTURE THAT:

17 1. WAS BUILT DURING THE 18TH OR 19TH CENTURY;

19 2. IS LISTED IN OR ELIGIBLE FOR LISTING IN THE
20 NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES;
