15	(a) There is a Handgun Roster Board in the Department of State Police.
16	(b) (1) The Board consists of 11 members.
17	(2) Of the 11 members of the Board:
18	(i) one shall be the Secretary as an ex officio member; and
19 20	(ii) ten shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate.

7 8	(iv) one shall be a resident of the State who is a representative of the National Rifle Association or its affiliated State association;
9 10 11	(v) one shall be a representative of [the Marylanders Against Handgun Abuse] AN ORGANIZATION THAT ADVOCATES AGAINST GUN VIOLENCE; and
12 13	(vi) five shall be public members, two of whom shall be mechanical or electrical engineers.
14	(c) The term of an appointed member is 4 years.
15	(d) The Secretary shall serve as chairman.
