A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Motor Vehicle Excise Tax – Leased Vehicles – Residual Value

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a lessor from passing on to the lessee the portion of the
motor vehicle excise tax paid by the lessor on the residual value of a leased
vehicle; providing that a lessor is entitled to a refund of the portion of the motor
vehicle excise tax paid by the lessor on the residual value of a leased vehicle;
requiring a lessor to apply to the Motor Vehicle Administration on a certain
form in order to obtain a refund; defining certain terms; and generally relating
to the motor vehicle excise tax and the residual value of leased vehicles.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- Article Transportation

 19 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE
 20 MEANINGS INDICATED.
- 21 (2) "EXCISE TAX" MEANS THE EXCISE TAX IMPOSED BY THIS 22 PART.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 (3) "LEASE AGREEMENT" MEANS A CONTRACT IN THE FORM OF A 2 BAILMENT OR LEASE FOR THE USE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE FOR A PERIOD OF TIME 3 EXCEEDING 180 CONSECUTIVE DAYS, INCLUDING RENEWAL PERIODS, WHETHER 4 OR NOT THE LESSEE HAS THE OPTION TO PURCHASE OR OTHERWISE BECOME 5 THE OWNER OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE AT THE EXPIRATION OF THE LEASE.

6 (4) "RESIDUAL VALUE" MEANS THE VALUE OF A LEASED VEHICLE 7 AT THE END OF THE LEASE TERM AS DETERMINED BY THE MANUFACTURER.

8 (B) AS PART OF A LEASE AGREEMENT, THE LESSOR MAY NOT PASS ON
9 TO THE LESSEE THE PORTION OF THE EXCISE TAX PAID BY THE LESSOR ON THE
10 RESIDUAL VALUE OF THE LEASED VEHICLE.

(C) (1) AFTER ENTERING INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT, THE LESSOR IS
 ENTITLED TO A REFUND OF THE PORTION OF THE EXCISE TAX PAID BY THE
 LESSOR ON THE RESIDUAL VALUE OF THE LEASED VEHICLE.

14 (2) TO OBTAIN A REFUND UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE LESSOR
 15 SHALL APPLY TO THE ADMINISTRATION ON A FORM THE ADMINISTRATION
 16 REQUIRES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2008.
