1 AN ACT concerning

## Motor Vehicles – Registration for Individuals with Disabilities

- 3 FOR the purpose of creating an exception to a provision of law limiting the acceptance 4 of applications for special disability vehicle registrations to authorize the Motor 5 Vehicle Administration to accept an application for an additional special 6 disability registration from an applicant who possesses a valid special disability 7 registration and possessed two valid special registrations before a certain date; 8 prohibiting the Administration from issuing a special disability parking placard 9 to a person who requests a certain number of special disability registrations; 10 and generally relating to special disability registrations.
