7 8	(b) (1) The Adjutant General shall keep all records required to be kept and filed with the Adjutant General's office.
9 10 11	(2) On or before each October 15, the Adjutant General shall submit to the Governor a detailed statement of all the receipts and expenditures for military purposes during the year ending the previous September 30.
12	(c) (1) The Adjutant General is responsible for:
13	(i) each armory that the State owns; and
l4 l5	(ii) each building or other property purchased, occupied, or leased by or on behalf of the State military forces.
16 17 18 19	(2) If the Adjutant General rejects an application to use an armory for nonmilitary purposes, the application is subject to review and approval by the Board of Public Works, the Adjutant General, and the commanding officer of the unit occupying that armory.
20 21	(3) The Adjutant General may adopt regulations to enforce this subsection.
22 23	(d) The Adjutant General is the custodian of battle flags and war records and is responsible for their proper care and preservation.
24	(e) The Adjutant General may employ employees as required.
25 26 27	(F) (1) THE ADJUTANT GENERAL SHALL DETERMINE THE QUALIFICATIONS, APPOINTMENT, REMOVAL, AND COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT.
