11 12	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- The Secretary of State shall adopt regulations to establish fees, not to 15 16 exceed [\$2] \$3 for an original notarial act, and an appropriate lesser amount for the repetition of that original notarial act or to make a copy of the matter addressed by 17 18 that original notarial act.
- 19 A notary public may charge 19 cents per mile, or a higher amount set by regulation of the Secretary of State, and a fee not to exceed \$5, as compensation for 20 travel required for the performance of a notarial act. 21
- 22SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 October 1, 2008.
