## Notary Public - Fees

FOR the purpose of increasing the maximum fee that the Secretary of State may establish by regulation for an original notarial act; and generally relating to fees charged by notaries public.

Annotated Code of Maryland
(2004 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement)
SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - State Government

18-112.
(a) The Secretary of State shall adopt regulations to establish fees, not to exceed [\$2] \$3 for an original notarial act, and an appropriate lesser amount for the repetition of that original notarial act or to make a copy of the matter addressed by that original notarial act.

[^0](b) A notary public may charge 19 cents per mile, or a higher amount set by regulation of the Secretary of State, and a fee not to exceed $\$ 5$, as compensation for travel required for the performance of a notarial act.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
