19 (B) IN THIS SECTION, "OPIOID TREATMENT FACILITY" MEANS A DRUG 20 ABUSE TREATMENT PROGRAM THAT ADMINISTERS METHADONE, OPIATE, OR 21 OPIATE REPLACEMENT IN THE TREATMENT, MAINTENANCE, OR 22 DETOXIFICATION OF INDIVIDUALS.
