Teenage Protection Pilot Program

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain facilities performing certain procedures to offer certain options to certain patients; requiring certain facilities to provide a 4 5 certain form to be signed by certain patients; providing for the information to be provided on the form; requiring the form to be maintained in the medical record 6 7 of the patient for a certain time period; providing for a certain penalty; defining a certain term; providing that this Act applies in Anne Arundel County; 8 9 providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Teenage 10 Protection Pilot Program.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 17
- 18 Article - Health - General
- 19 20-215.
- IN THIS SECTION, "PATIENT" MEANS A WOMAN UNDER THE AGE OF 20 (A)
- 20 YEARS. 21
- 22 **(B)** THIS SECTION APPLIES IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY.

- 1 (C) PRIOR TO PERFORMING AN ABORTION ON A PATIENT, A FACILITY
 2 THAT PROVIDES ABORTION SERVICES AND IS EQUIPPED WITH
 3 ULTRASONOGRAPHY EQUIPMENT SHALL:
- 4 (1) OFFER THE PATIENT THE OPTION TO VIEW THE IMAGE OF THE 5 FETUS ON THE ULTRASONOGRAPHY EQUIPMENT;
- 6 (2) OFFER THE PATIENT THE OPTION TO RECEIVE AN IMAGE 7 PRINTOUT OF THE FETUS FROM THE ULTRASONOGRAPHY EQUIPMENT; AND
- 8 (3) REQUIRE THE PATIENT TO SIGN A "TEENAGE 9 INFORMATIONAL FORM".
- 10 (D) THE "TEENAGE INFORMATIONAL FORM" REQUIRED UNDER 11 SUBSECTION (C)(3) OF THIS SECTION SHALL:
- 12 (1) REQUIRE THE PATIENT TO SIGN WHETHER THE PATIENT 13 ACCEPTS OR REJECTS HER RIGHT TO VIEW THE IMAGE OF THE FETUS ON THE 14 ULTRASONOGRAPHY EQUIPMENT; AND
- 15 (2) REQUIRE THE PATIENT TO SIGN WHETHER THE PATIENT 16 ACCEPTS OR REJECTS HER RIGHT TO RECEIVE AN IMAGE PRINTOUT OF THE 17 FETUS FROM THE ULTRASONOGRAPHY EQUIPMENT.
- 18 (E) THE "TEENAGE INFORMATIONAL FORM" SHALL BE MAINTAINED IN 19 THE MEDICAL RECORD OF THE PATIENT UNTIL THE PATIENT IS AT LEAST 20 YEARS OLD.
- 21 (F) A PERSON WHO FAILS TO MAINTAIN A SIGNED COPY OF THE 22 "TEENAGE INFORMATIONAL FORM" AS REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION IS GUILTY 23 OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT 24 EXCEEDING \$1,000.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2008. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30, 2011, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
