16 17	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 $21$	(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a motor carrier permit is required for a passenger motor vehicle used in the transportation of persons for hire.

- 24 (c) The public duties of a common carrier may not be imposed on a person 25 with respect to a vehicle for which a motor carrier permit is required under this section, if the vehicle is not actually engaged in public transportation.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
