A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Task Force to Study the Cost of Illegal Aliens in 4 Maryland; providing for the membership and duties of the Task Force; 5 providing for the designation of a chair of the Task Force; requiring the Department of Business and Economic Development to provide staff for the 6 Task Force; prohibiting members of the Task Force from receiving certain 7 compensation; authorizing a member to receive certain reimbursement; 8 9 requiring the Task Force to report its findings and recommendations to the 10 Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Task Force to Study 11 the Cost of Illegal Aliens in Maryland. 12
- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That:
 - (a) There is a Task Force to Study the Cost of Illegal Aliens in Maryland.
- 16 (b) The Task Force consists of the following members:
- 17 (1) two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the 18 President of the Senate;
- 19 (2) two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker 20 of the House;
- 21 (3) the Secretary of Business and Economic Development, or the 22 Secretary's designee;
- 23 (4) the Attorney General, or the Attorney General's designee; and
