1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Sex Offender Registry – ~~Identifying~~ Additional Information**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring ~~that~~ the inclusion of certain additional information in a
4 registration statement of an individual required to register as a sex offender
5 include the registrant's current or former aliases, names, nicknames, chat room
6 identities, computer log-in or screen names, Internet identities, and instant
7 messaging identities that the registrant has used for the sex offender registry;
8 and generally relating to registration statements of ~~sex~~ certain offenders.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Criminal Procedure**

18 (a) A registration statement shall include:

1 (1) the registrant's full name, including any suffix, and address;

2 (2) (i) for a registrant under § 11-704(a)(7)(i) of this subtitle or
3 who is on work release, the registrant's place of employment; or

4 (ii) for a registrant under § 11-704(a)(7)(ii) of this subtitle, the
5 registrant's place of educational institution or school enrollment;

6 (3) (i) for a registrant enrolled, or expecting to enroll, in an
7 institution of higher education in the State as a full-time or part-time student, the
8 name and address of the institution of higher education; or

9 (ii) for a registrant who carries on employment, or expects to
10 carry on employment, at an institution of higher education in the State, the name and
11 address of the institution of higher education;

12 (4) a description of the crime for which the registrant was convicted;

13 (5) the date that the registrant was convicted;

14 (6) the jurisdiction in which the registrant was convicted;

15 (7) a list of any ~~CURRENT OR FORMER~~ aliases, **FORMER NAMES,**
16 **NICKNAMES, CHAT ROOM IDENTITIES, ELECTRONIC MAIL ADDRESSES,**
17 **COMPUTER LOG-IN OR SCREEN NAMES OR IDENTITIES, INTERNET IDENTITIES,**
18 **AND INSTANT-MESSAGING IDENTITIES, AND ELECTRONIC CHAT ROOM**
19 **IDENTITIES** that the registrant has used;

20 (8) the registrant's Social Security number;

21 (9) any other name by which the registrant has been legally known;

23 **(10) A COPY OF THE REGISTRANT'S VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE OR**
24 **IDENTIFICATION CARD;**

25 **(11) THE LICENSE PLATE NUMBER AND DESCRIPTION OF ANY**
26 **VEHICLE OWNED OR REGULARLY OPERATED BY THE REGISTRANT; AND**

27 ~~(10)~~ **(12)** the registrant's signature and date signed.

28 (b) If the registrant is a sexually violent predator, the registration statement
29 shall also include:

30 (1) identifying factors, including a physical description;

31 (2) anticipated future residence, if known at the time of registration;

1 (3) offense history; and

2 (4) documentation of treatment received for a mental abnormality or
3 personality disorder.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 October 1, 2008.
