Public Institutions of Higher Education - Textbook Fairness Act

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the governing board of a public institution of higher 4 education to notify students of the textbooks assigned for certain courses on the website of the institution at a certain time; requiring that the notification 5 6 contain certain information; prohibiting an employee of a public institution of 7 higher education from receiving certain benefits in exchange for requiring 8 students to purchase certain textbooks; providing for the scope of this Act; and 9 generally relating to textbooks assigned for courses at public institutions of 10 higher education.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (A) (1) THE GOVERNING BOARD OF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF
 21 HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL NOTIFY STUDENTS OF THE TEXTBOOKS ASSIGNED
 22 FOR EACH COURSE OFFERED AT THE INSTITUTION BY LISTING EACH ASSIGNED
 23 TEXTBOOK ON THE WEBSITE OF THE INSTITUTION WHEN THE COURSE
- 24 INSTRUCTOR OR ACADEMIC DEPARTMENT OFFERING THE COURSE IDENTIFIES
- 25 THE TEXTBOOK FOR ORDER AND SUBSEQUENT STUDENT PURCHASE.

- 3 (B) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, AN EMPLOYEE OF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION MAY NOT DEMAND OR RECEIVE ANY PAYMENT, LOAN, SUBSCRIPTION, ADVANCE, SERVICE, OR ANY OTHER BENEFIT IN EXCHANGE FOR REQUIRING STUDENTS TO PURCHASE A SPECIFIC TEXTBOOK FOR A COURSE.
- 8 (2) AN EMPLOYEE OF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER 9 EDUCATION MAY RECEIVE:
- 10 (I) A COPY OF A TEXTBOOK THAT MAY NOT BE SOLD, 11 INCLUDING A SAMPLE COPY, INSTRUCTOR'S COPY, AND INSTRUCTIONAL 12 MATERIAL; AND
- 13 (II) ROYALTIES OR OTHER COMPENSATION FROM THE SALE 14 OF A TEXTBOOK THAT INCLUDES THE WRITING OR WORK OF THE EMPLOYEE.
- 15 (C) This section does not apply to the overseas programs of 16 The University of Maryland University College.
- 17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 July 1, 2008.
