FOR the purpose of authorizing the governing documents of a homeowners association to be amended by a certain percentage of votes and at a certain frequency, unless the governing document provides for a lower percentage and a greater frequency; defining a certain term; and generally relating to amendment of the governing documents of a homeowners association.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 11B-116 of Article - Real Property of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 11B-117.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Real Property

11B-116.
(A) IN THIS SECTION, "GOVERNING DOCUMENT" INCLUDES:
(1) A DECLARATION;
(2) BYLAWS;
(3) A DEED AND AGREEMENT; AND
(4) RECORDED COVENANTS AND RESTRICTIONS.
(B) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF A GOVERNING DOCUMENT, A HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION MAY AMEND THE GOVERNING DOCUMENT:
(1) UNLESS A LOWER PERCENTAGE IS REQUIRED IN THE GOVERNING DOCUMENT, BY THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF LOT OWNERS HAVING AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS OF THE VOTES IN THE DEVELOPMENT; AND
(2) UNLESS A GREATER FREQUENCY IS ALLOWED BY THE GOVERNING DOCUMENT, AT LEAST ONCE EVERY 5 YEARS.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
