1 (e) A member of the Commission:

(1) may not receive compensation as a member of the Commission; but

3 (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard 4 State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

5 (f) The Commission shall study and make recommendations regarding 6 protecting and preserving Maryland's commercial fishing industry's access to public 7 trust waters.

8 (g) On or before [December 15, 2007] **DECEMBER 1, 2008**, the Commission 9 shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with 10 § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 June 1, 2007. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year **AND 7 MONTHS** and, at 13 the end of [May] **DECEMBER** 31, 2008, with no further action required by the General 14 Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect16 June 1, 2008.
