CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County – State’s Attorney – Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of ~~clarifying~~ establishing the salary of the State’s Attorney for
4 Baltimore County beginning with the State’s Attorney elected in a certain year;
5 providing that the salary be increased annually by a certain ~~amount~~ percentage
6 until a certain date; ~~clarifying language; providing that this Act does not apply~~
7 to the salary or compensation of the incumbent State’s Attorney for Baltimore
8 County; and generally relating to the State’s Attorney for Baltimore County.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article – Criminal Procedure**

13 15–404.

14 (a) This section applies only in Baltimore County.

15 (b) **(1)** Subject to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, ~~and~~ **AND**
16 **PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION**, beginning with the term of the State’s
17 Attorney who was elected to that position in 1982, the State’s Attorney’s salary~~†~~:

18 ~~(1)~~ **(I)** is equal to the salary of a circuit court judge; and

19 ~~(2)~~ **(II)** shall be increased 5% each year during the State’s
20 Attorney’s term of office~~†~~.

21 ~~(1) (I) BEGINNING ON JANUARY 2, 2008~~ **BEGINNING WITH THE**
22 **TERM OF THE STATE’S ATTORNEY ELECTED TO THAT POSITION IN 2010, THE**
23 **SALARY OF THE STATE’S ATTORNEY IS \$194,276; AND**

24 ~~(2) (II) IN FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING ON JANUARY 1, 2012, AND~~
25 **EACH YEAR THEREAFTER UNTIL JANUARY 1, 2023, THE SALARY SHALL BE**
26 **INCREASED BY THE SAME ANNUAL COST OF LIVING INCREASE RECEIVED BY**
27 **BALTIMORE COUNTY EMPLOYEES 1%.**

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §
29 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to
30 the salary or compensation of the State’s Attorney for Baltimore County in office on
31 the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or
32 compensation of the State’s Attorney for Baltimore County shall take effect at the
33 beginning of the next following term of office.

1 SECTION ~~2~~ 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
2 effect July 1, 2008.
