2 (N) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY CONSIDER A 3 PETITION PRESENTED TO THE BOARD AS A FACTOR IN DETERMINING WHETHER 4 TO TAKE THE ACTION SOUGHT BY THE PETITION ONLY IF EACH SIGNATURE 5 CONTAINED IN THE PETITION HAS BEEN VERIFIED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF 6 ELECTIONS AS THAT OF A REGISTERED VOTER IN THE COUNTY.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 July 1, 2008.
