## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages - Drive-Through Purchase**  
3 **Facilities**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Board of License Commissioners in Prince George's  
5 County from issuing or transferring an alcoholic beverages license for use in a  
6 drive-through purchase facility in which alcoholic beverages are sold at retail  
7 and dispensed through a door or window to purchasers in or on a motor vehicle;  
8 and generally relating to alcoholic beverages sales in Prince George's County.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
10 Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages  
11 Section 9–217(a)  
12 Annotated Code of Maryland  
13 (2005 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement)

14 BY adding to  
15 Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages  
16 Section 9–217(n)  
17 Annotated Code of Maryland  
18 (2005 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement)

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

22 9–217.

23 (a) This section applies only in Prince George's County.

2 TRANSFER AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE OF ANY CLASS FOR USE IN A  
3 DRIVE-THROUGH PURCHASE FACILITY IN WHICH ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE  
4 TO BE:

5                   (1)   SOLD AT RETAIL; AND

6                   (2)   DISPENSED THROUGH A WINDOW OR DOOR TO A PURCHASER  
7 IN OR ON A MOTOR VEHICLE.

8           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
9 July 1, 2008.
