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## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County – Alcoholic Beverages – Drive-Through Purchase**  
3 **Facilities**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Board of License Commissioners in Prince  
5 George's County from issuing ~~or transferring an~~ a new alcoholic beverages  
6 license on or after a certain date for use in a drive-through purchase facility in  
7 which alcoholic beverages are sold at retail and dispensed through a door or  
8 window to purchasers in or on a motor vehicle; providing for the application of  
9 this Act; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages sales in Prince George's  
10 County.

11 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (a) This section applies only in Prince George’s County.

4 (N) ~~THE~~ **ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2008, THE BOARD OF LICENSE**  
5 **COMMISSIONERS MAY NOT ISSUE OR TRANSFER AN A NEW ALCOHOLIC**  
6 **BEVERAGES LICENSE OF ANY CLASS FOR USE IN A DRIVE-THROUGH PURCHASE**  
7 **FACILITY IN WHICH ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE TO BE:**

8 (1) **SOLD AT RETAIL; AND**

9 (2) **DISPENSED THROUGH A WINDOW OR DOOR TO A PURCHASER**  
10 **IN OR ON A MOTOR VEHICLE.**

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be  
12 construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have  
13 any effect on or application to any alcoholic beverages license issued before the  
14 effective date of this Act.

15 SECTION ~~2~~ 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take  
16 effect July 1, 2008.
