1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Higher Education – Tuition Reduction for Nonresident Nursing Students –**
3 **Service Obligation**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the service obligation for certain nursing students
5 receiving a certain tuition reduction at a public institution of higher education;
6 and generally relating to the tuition reduction program for nonresident nursing
7 students.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Education**

16 18–110.

17 (a) Any student attending a public institution of higher education who is not
18 a resident of this State and who is enrolled in an education course or program leading
19 to an occupation as a licensed registered nurse or a licensed practical nurse shall pay

1 only the tuition fees and other mandatory fees payable by a resident of this State if the
2 student furnishes a surety bond or promissory note to this State, with security
3 satisfactory to the Maryland Higher Education Commission, that, on completion of the
4 education course or program, the student will work in this State for [at least 4 years]
5 **1 YEAR FOR EACH YEAR A TUITION REDUCTION WAS RECEIVED** as a licensed
6 registered nurse or a licensed practical nurse in a hospital or related institution, as
7 defined in § 19–301 of the Health – General Article.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 2008.
