1 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 2 MEANINGS INDICATED.

3 (2) "FARM PRODUCT" MEANS ANY AGRICULTURAL,
4 HORTICULTURAL, VEGETABLE, FRUIT PRODUCT, WHETHER RAW, CANNED,
5 FROZEN, DRIED, PICKLED, OR OTHERWISE PROCESSED, LIVESTOCK, MEATS,
6 MARINE FOOD PRODUCTS, POULTRY, EGGS, DAIRY PRODUCTS, NUTS, HONEY,
7 AND EVERY EDIBLE PRODUCT OF FARM, ORCHARD, GARDEN, OR WATER.

8 (3) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE JANE LAWTON FARM-TO-SCHOOL
9 PROGRAM.

10 (B) THERE IS A JANE LAWTON FARM-TO-SCHOOL PROGRAM IN THE 11 DEPARTMENT.

12 (C) THE PROGRAM IS ESTABLISHED FOR THE PURPOSE OF:

13(1)PROMOTING THE SALE OF FARM PRODUCTS GROWN IN THE14STATE TO STATE MARYLAND SCHOOLS AND FACILITIES IN CONSULTATION WITH15THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS;

16 (2) SOLICITING FARMERS TO SELL THEIR FARM PRODUCTS TO 17 STATE MARYLAND SCHOOLS AND FACILITIES;

18 (3) DEVELOPING AND REGULARLY UPDATING A DATABASE OF 19 FARMERS INTERESTED IN SELLING THEIR FARM PRODUCTS TO STATE 20 <u>MARYLAND</u> SCHOOLS AND FACILITIES, INCLUDING THE TYPES AND AMOUNTS 21 OF FARM PRODUCTS THE FARMERS WANT TO SELL AND THE TIME PERIODS 22 THAT THE FARMERS WANT TO SELL;

(4) FACILITATING PURCHASES FROM FARMERS BY INTERESTED
 STATE MARYLAND SCHOOLS AND FACILITIES IN CONSULTATION WITH THE
 STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND IN COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE
 PROCUREMENT REQUIREMENTS AND THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS; AND

(5) PROVIDING OUTREACH AND GUIDANCE TO FARMERS
 CONCERNING THE VALUE OF AND PROCEDURE FOR SELLING THEIR FARM
 PRODUCTS TO INTERESTED STATE MARYLAND SCHOOLS AND FACILITIES.

30 (D) (1) THE PROGRAM, IN CONSULTATION PARTNERSHIP WITH THE
 31 STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS, AND IN
 32 <u>CONSULTATION WITH</u> SCHOOL FOOD SERVICE DIRECTORS, AND INTERESTED
 33 FARMING ORGANIZATIONS, SHALL ESTABLISH PROMOTIONAL EVENTS THAT

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1 PROMOTE STATE AGRICULTURE AND FARM PRODUCTS TO CHILDREN THROUGH 2 SCHOOL MEAL AND CLASSROOM PROGRAMS. 3 (2) **AT LEAST ONE PROMOTIONAL EVENT SHALL:** 4 **(I)** LAST FOR A PERIOD OF 1 WEEK; 5 BE KNOWN AS "MARYLAND HOMEGROWN SCHOOL **(II)** 6 LUNCH WEEK";  $\mathbf{7}$ (III) PROMOTE STATE AGRICULTURE AND FARM PRODUCTS 8 TO CHILDREN THROUGH SCHOOL MEAL AND CLASSROOM PROGRAMS; AND 9 (IV) ARRANGE FOR INTERACTION BETWEEN STUDENTS AND 10 FARMERS<del>, INCLUDING</del> THROUGH PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES THAT MAY 11 INCLUDE FIELD TRIPS TO FARMS AND IN-SCHOOL PRESENTATIONS BY 12FARMERS. 13SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 14 October 1, 2008.
