In this section, "small procurement" means a procurement for which:

(2) a contractor provides services subject to § 11–202(3) of this articl for expected annual revenues of \$25,000 or less; <b>OR</b>
(3) THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES IS SEEKING TO AWARD A PROCUREMENT CONTRACT FOR A CONSTRUCTION WITH A VALUE THAT IS \$50,000 OR LESS.
