BY repealing Article – Business Regulation Section 11–636 Annotated Code of Maryland (2004 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement)
SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
Article – Business Regulation
[11–636.
(a) If there are fewer than 2 separate qualified entries in a Fund Race, the Commission shall cancel the Fund Race.
