- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from knowingly and willfully obtaining or exerting unauthorized control over a lottery ticket, equipment, or products for 4 certain purposes; prohibiting a person from knowingly presenting or giving to 5 another to present for payment a stolen, counterfeit, altered, or misdelivered 6 lottery ticket; providing penalties for a violation of this Act; providing that 7 8 certain offenses do not preclude prosecution under certain other statutes; 9 providing for the merger of certain convictions under certain circumstances; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the theft, unauthorized use, or 10 misrepresentation of State Lottery tickets, equipment, or products. 11
