12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 THE SALES AND USE TAX DOES NOT APPLY TO THE SALE OF COMPUTER 17 SERVICES TO BE USED DIRECTLY AND PREDOMINANTLY IN FULFILLING A 18 CONTRACT WITH THE FEDERAL OR STATE GOVERNMENT OR A SUBCONTRACT 19 UNDER A CONTRACT WITH THE FEDERAL OR STATE GOVERNMENT.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 July 1, 2008. It shall remain effective until the taking effect of the termination 22 provision specified in Section 13 of Chapter 3 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 23 the 2007 Special Session.
