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Consumer Products Safety - Lead and Mercury Reduction Act
Statewide Advisory Commission on Immunizations - Influenza
Vaccines - Study

5 FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain persons from administering vaccines that 6 contain more than a certain amount of mercury per dose; prohibiting the sale, 7 offer for sale, or distribution in the State of certain drugs that contain mercury; 8 prohibiting the sale, offer for sale, or distribution in the State of cosmetics that 9 contain lead or mercury; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally 10 relating to prohibitions against the administering of vaccines with specified levels of mercury and the sale of cosmetics and specified drugs that contain 11 mercury requiring the Statewide Advisory Commission on Immunizations to 12 13 conduct a certain study; requiring the Commission to make a certain report to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date; and 14 15 generally relating to the Statewide Advisory Commission on Immunizations and 16 a study on the influenza vaccine.
