A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County - Annual Financial Report - Filing Date**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the date by which Frederick County may file its annual
4 financial report for the fiscal year with the Maryland Department of Legislative
5 Services; and generally relating to the annual financial report of Frederick
6 County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
8 Article 19 – Comptroller

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 19 – Comptroller**

15 37.

16 (a) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, each
17 county, municipal corporation, and taxing district in the State shall by the first day of
18 November after the close of the fiscal year file with the Department of Legislative
19 Services its financial report covering the full period of that fiscal year.

20 (2) (i) Each county, municipal corporation, or taxing district with a
21 population of more than 400,000 may by the first day of January after the close of the
22 fiscal year file with the Department of Legislative Services its financial report
23 covering the full period of that fiscal year.

1 (ii) Unless subparagraph (i) of this paragraph applies, Howard
2 County may by the first day of December after the close of the fiscal year file with the
3 Department of Legislative Services its financial report covering the full period of that
4 fiscal year.

5 **(iii) FREDERICK COUNTY MAY BY THE FIRST DAY OF**
6 **JANUARY AFTER THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR FILE WITH THE DEPARTMENT**
7 **OF LEGISLATIVE SERVICES ITS FINANCIAL REPORT COVERING THE FULL**
8 **PERIOD OF THAT FISCAL YEAR.**

9 (b) The reports required by subsection (a) of this section shall be:

10 (1) Properly filled in on the form or forms established by the
11 Department as provided in this subtitle; and

12 (2) Verified by the chief executive officer of each county, municipal
13 corporation, and taxing district.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 October 1, 2008.
