A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loans of 2005 and 2006 – Baltimore**
3 **City – Waxter Center for Senior Citizens**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loans of 2005
5 and 2006 to expand the authorized uses of a certain grant to the Mayor and City
6 Council of the City of Baltimore.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Chapter 445 of the Acts of 2005**

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That:

18 (3) ZA02 LOCAL SENATE INITIATIVES

19 (Y) Waxter Center for Senior Citizens. Provide a grant
20 equal to the lesser of (i) \$100,000 or (ii) the amount of
21 the matching fund provided, to the Mayor and City
22 Council of the City of Baltimore for the repair,
23 renovation, reconstruction, [and] capital equipping,
24 **AND NEW CONSTRUCTION** of the Waxter Center for
25 Senior Citizens, located in Baltimore City.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

5 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 6 MARYLAND, That:

8 (K) Waxter Center for Senior Citizens. Provide a grant
 9 equal to the lesser of (i) \$250,000 or (ii) the amount of
 10 the matching fund provided, to the Mayor and City
 11 Council of the City of Baltimore for the repair,
 12 renovation, reconstruction, [and] capital equipping,
 13 **AND NEW CONSTRUCTION** of the Waxter Center for
 14 Senior Citizens, located in Baltimore City.
 15 Notwithstanding Section 1(5) of this Act, the
 16 matching fund may consist of funds expended prior to
 17 the effective date of this Act (Baltimore City) 250,000

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 19 June 1, 2008.
