4 FOR the purpose of providing that, in certain foreclosure actions, the court may only approve a trustee commission and attorney's fees that the court finds 5 6 reasonable after considering certain factors; prohibiting the court from 7 approving a trustee commission or attorney's fees exceeding certain amounts; 8 and generally relating to trustee commissions and attorney's fees in certain 9 foreclosure actions.

15SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article – Real Property

19 (A) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF THE MORTGAGE OR DEED 20 OF TRUST, AND SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, IN AN ACTION 21TO FORECLOSE A MORTGAGE OR DEED OF TRUST ON RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY 22IMPROVED BY FOUR OR FEWER SINGLE FAMILY DWELLING UNITS, THE COURT 23MAY ONLY APPROVE A TRUSTEE COMMISSION AND ATTORNEY'S FEES THAT THE 24COURT FINDS REASONABLE AFTER CONSIDERING THE FACTORS ENUMERATED 25IN RULE 1.5 OF THE MARYLAND RULES OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT.



- 1 (B) THE COURT MAY NOT APPROVE:
- 2 (1) A TRUSTEE COMMISSION EXCEEDING \$500; OR
- 3 (2) ATTORNEY'S FEES EXCEEDING \$800.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2008.
