- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of the Environment and the Department of Natural Resources to reimburse Anne Arundel County for the 5 cost of certain environmental health monitoring and testing under certain 6 7 circumstances; requiring a reimbursement only if a certain fine is collected; 8 limiting the amount of a reimbursement to a certain amount; providing that 9 this Act shall apply retroactively only to certain costs incurred by Anne Arundel 10 County; and generally relating to requiring reimbursement of Anne Arundel County for the cost of certain environmental health monitoring and testing. 11
