- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

31 32 33 34 35	(3) (i) An individual who graduates from an accredited institution of higher education with a grade point average of at least 3.5 on a 4.0 scale or it equivalent, becomes employed by a county board, and remains employed as classroom teacher in the public school system for a minimum of 3 consecutive year shall receive a salary signing bonus of \$1,000.

- 1 (ii) If the individual leaves employment with the public school system before the end of the 3-year commitment, the individual shall reimburse the State in the amount of \$1,000.
- 4 (4) A classroom teacher who holds an advanced professional certificate and teaches in a public school identified by the State Board as a school in corrective action, a school in restructuring, or a challenge school shall receive a stipend from the State in the amount of \$2,000 for each year that the teacher performs satisfactorily in the classroom.
- 9 (c) An individual who receives a stipend or bonus under subsection (b) of this section may not be deemed an employee of the State.
- 11 (d) The employer of an individual who receives a stipend or bonus under 12 subsection (b) of this section shall pay the increase in fringe benefit costs associated 13 with the stipend or bonus.
- 14 (e) The Department shall act as fiscal agent for funds disbursed under this 15 section.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
