1 AN ACT concerning

Allegany County - Investment for Video Lottery Construction Reimbursement for Local Impact Grants - Rocky Gap Construction Costs

FOR the purpose of requiring that, to the extent that money remains after payment of 4 certain costs for video lottery terminals on a location on State property $\mathbf{5}$ 6 associated with Rocky Gap State Park. Allegany County be reimbursed up to a 7 certain amount for its contribution toward constructing certain improvements 8 in Rocky Gap State Park; providing that money reimbursed to the county be 9 considered part of the direct investment in construction and related costs 10 required of an applicant for a video lottery operation license; authorizing local impact grants from proceeds of certain video lottery terminals to be used in 11 Allegany County for certain purposes and to pay down certain debt incurred by 12the County in the construction and related costs for the golf course, lodge, and 13 other improvements in Rocky Gap State Park; making this Act contingent on 14 15the taking effect of another Act; and generally relating to video lottery gaming and local impact grants from gaming proceeds in Allegany County. 16
