- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Correctional Services

21 9–609.

(a) Whenever a date of release from confinement in a State correctional
facility is a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the inmate shall be released on the
first preceding day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday.

(b) The Commissioner **OF CORRECTION** shall adopt regulations:

2 (1) establishing a release plan for inmates upon release from 3 confinement in a State correctional facility to help identify resources to assist inmates 4 following release, including the provision of transportation from the facility for an 5 inmate upon release; AND

6 (2) IMPLEMENTING THE PROVISIONS OF § **9–609.1** OF THIS 7 SUBTITLE CONCERNING ISSUANCE OF AN IDENTIFICATION CARD TO INMATES 8 ON RELEASE FROM CONFINEMENT IN A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.

10(A) THE COMMISSIONER OF CORRECTION SHALL ISSUE AN11IDENTIFICATION CARD TO AN INMATE ON RELEASE FROM CONFINEMENT IN A12STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.

(B) THE IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF
 THIS SECTION SHALL COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS FOR AN
 IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED BY THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION
 UNDER § 12–301 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2008.
