certain transition costs to reduce, in a certain manner, certain electricity rates;
and generally relating to the return of transition costs from Constellation
Energy Group, Inc., to Baltimore Gas and Electric Company.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY (A) OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE 20COMMISSION SHALL REQUIRE CONSTELLATION ENERGY GROUP, INC., TO 21RETURN, IN A MANNER APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION, TO THE BALTIMORE 22GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY THE \$975,000,000 IN BEFORE-TAX TRANSITION 23COSTS THAT WERE COLLECTED FROM CUSTOMERS BY BALTIMORE GAS AND 24ELECTRIC COMPANY IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 7-513 OF THIS SUBTITLE AND 25**PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION ORDER NO. 75757.**



1 (B) BALTIMORE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY SHALL USE THE 2 TRANSITION COSTS RETURNED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS 3 SECTION TO REDUCE, IN A MANNER APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION, 4 ELECTRICITY RATES FOR RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS IN THE BALTIMORE GAS 5 AND ELECTRIC SERVICE TERRITORY AFTER THE TRANSITION COSTS ARE 6 RETURNED.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectJune 1, 2008.
