BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 13 **Article - Criminal Law** 14 3-209.15 A person charged with a crime under § 3–202, § 3–203, § 3–204, or § 3–205 of 16 this subtitle may assert any judicially recognized defense, INCLUDING A CLAIM OF 17 SELF-DEFENSE EVEN THOUGH THE PERSON FAILED TO RETREAT OR SEEK 18 SAFETY BY ESCAPE. 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 2008.
